2) Discussion with James Wassenaar, Executive Director of Student Affairs about issues of relevance to the environment, planning, and student life.

- JW expressed interest in tying back programs related to sustainability to the curriculum.
- The LEED initiative continues to grow and Parkview housing is on the verge of LEED gold when it opens in mid-July 2013. The proximity of Parkview to the Preserve continues to be an asset.
- Committee members suggested that there be a special tour of Parkview for Faculty Senate members.
- JW is interested in creating bike lanes, and improve work with DOT to connect to Sweetwater. Likewise, he deals with Food Services, the Wolf and Graham Center.
- Programming Phase II of student housing will begin in two weeks. Parkview Phase II should provide a way to play out the ideas of the environment. JW is the chair of the Programming Committee.
- JW mentioned that housing is about 20% of the campus footprint and commented on the lack of outdoor recreation space.
- Peter expressed an interest in finding solutions for temporary housing at BBC and pointed out that this has not yet been a priority.
