

Global Learning Curriculum Oversight Committee

Year-End Faculty Senate Report 2016-2017

May 25, 2017

The Global Learning Curriculum Oversight Committee (GLCOC) oversees Global Learning (GL) courses at FIU. The committee approves new GL courses and reviews each GL designated course every 3 years to ensure they continue to meet GL standards. Most courses are approved with no further action needed, or approved with minor revisions. Some require faculty revision and resubmission. If a course fails to meet approval, faculty may elect to resubmit. The committee may recommend the removal of GL designation should a course fail to meet GL standards, or at the request of a department.

In 2016-2017, the committee approved 21 new courses and reviewed 22 existing courses. GL designation was removed from 3 courses at the request of their respective departments.

From B1 through B6, the GLCOC made the following recommendations. All were approved by the Senate:
